- Robert Summers has signed a memorandum of agreement to fund an endowment for a faculty position to be called the Dr. Donald Summers Chair of Physics. He will donate \$335,000.00 every year for 10 years. The endowment will be used to fund salary and research for the position. The funds cannot be used until all have been collected and start earning interest. Robert Summers is the brother of the late Donald Summers who was a professor in the department.
- The Department of Physics and Astronomy (along with other STEM departments) will be moving the introductory physics labs into the The Jim and Thomas Duff Center for Science and Technology Innovation to start teaching there in Fall 2024. Building construction is expected to be complete by April 2024 with overall site construction to be completed by May 2024. We expect to start moving in lab equipment starting in July 2024.
